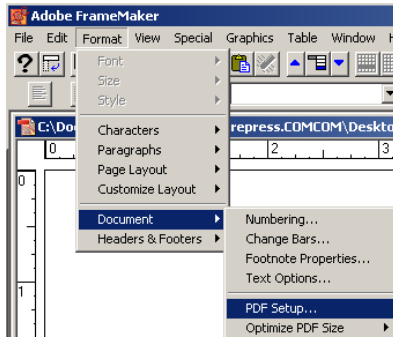


Writing a Print-Ready PDF from Adobe FrameMaker

To save a FrameMaker file as a PDF you need to have Adobe Distiller installed on your computer. FrameMaker does not include Distiller; you must purchase it separately.

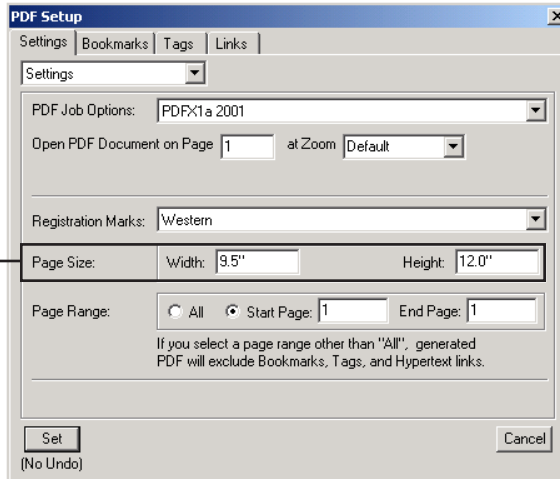
The following directions on writing a Print-Ready PDF requires the installation of Acrobat Professional on the computer creating the PDF.



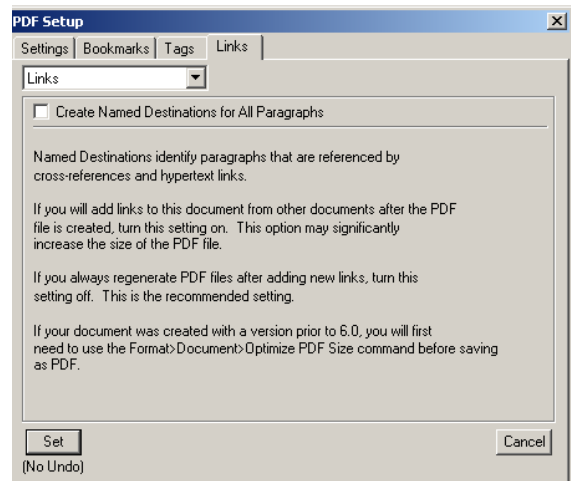
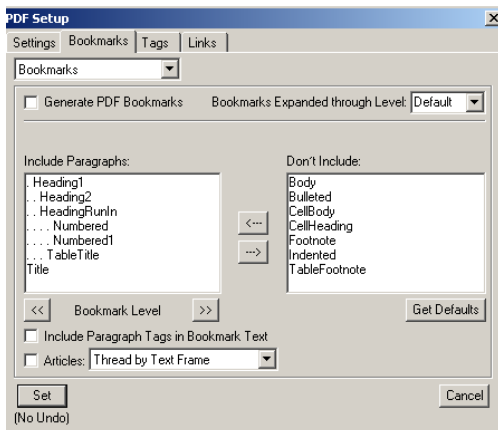
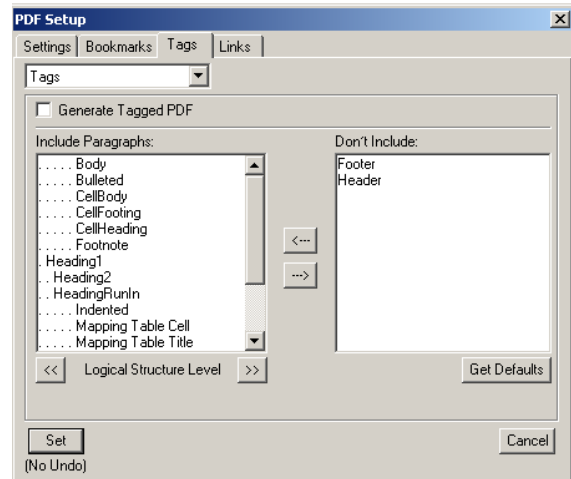
① Set options in PDF Setup Dialog Box

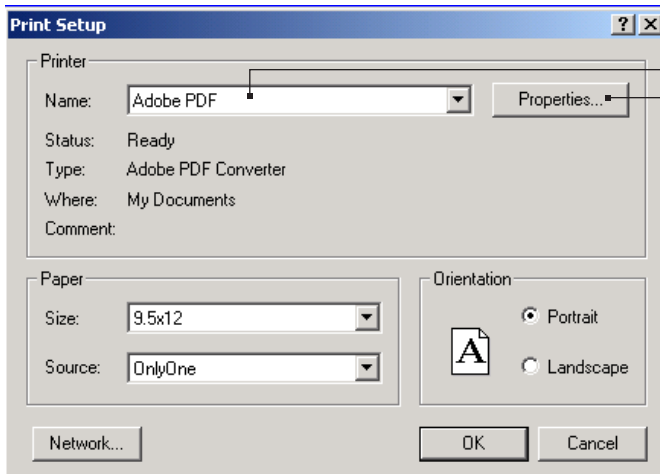
Format Menu > Document > PDF Setup...

Change settings to reflect those shown.



Your page size here should be 1" larger in width & height than your document.





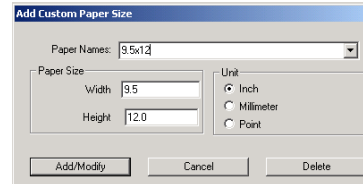
2 File Menu > Print Setup

Name: Choose Adobe PDF

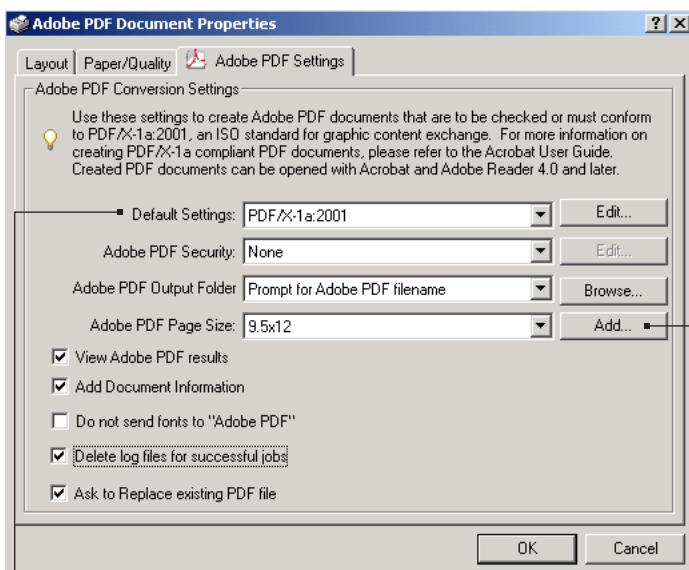
Properties

Go to the Adobe PDF Settings
Enter the settings shown here.

Click on Add...



Create your new page size
This size should be 1" larger than your
document size (height & width).



Layout—Make sure your orientation
is correct.

Paper Quality –

Paper Source: OnlyOne

Make sure Color is selected for color files.

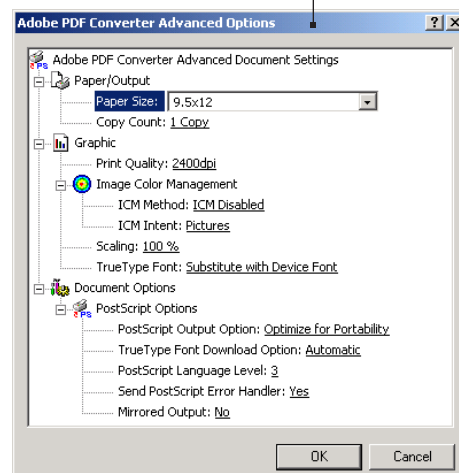
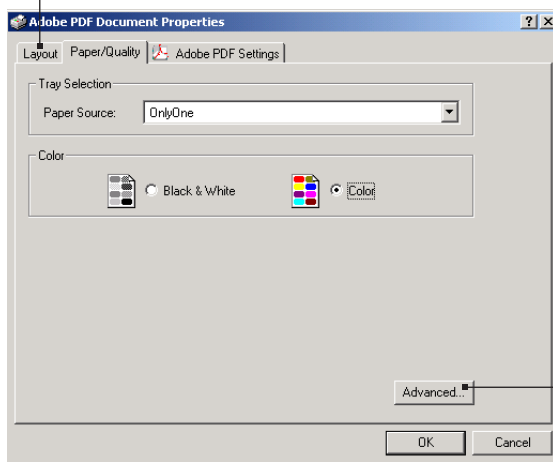
Select *Advanced*

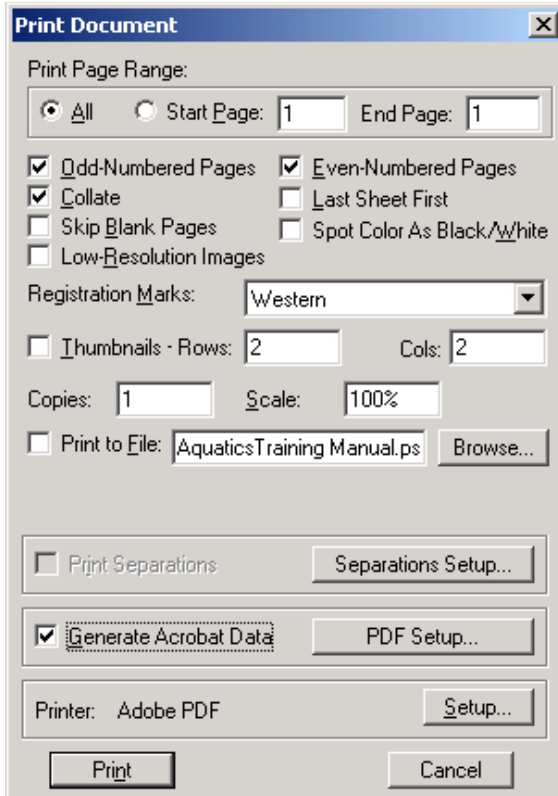
*Check that these settings are as

Click OK twice

Adobe PDF Settings

Default Settings—select the *PDF for Print* option previously set up
in MS Word or Excel. If you don't have this setting, then select
PDF/X-1a:2001





③ File Menu > Print

Make changes to reflect the settings shown to the left.

Click *Print*
